### State of the Union 2020

In her State of the Union address on 16 September 2020, President of the European Commission Ursula von der Leyen presented her vision for a Europe that emerges stronger from the pandemic and leads the way towards a new vitality.

### 2020 Strategic Foresight Report

This first annual Strategic Foresight Report, Strategic Foresight - Charting the course towards a more resilient Europe, presents the Commission's strategy to integrate strategic foresight into EU policy-making. It identifies first lessons from the COVID-19 crisis, introduces resilience as a new compass for EU policy-making and discusses the role of strategic foresight in strengthening the resilience of the EU and its Member States.

### European Comission (EU) | New Pact on Migration and Asylum

Migration is a complex issue, with many facets that need to be weighed together. The safety of people who seek international protection or a better life, the concerns of countries at the EU's external borders, which worry that migratory pressures will exceed their capacities and which need solidarity from others. Or the concerns of other EU Member States, which are concerned that, if procedures are not respected at the external borders, their own national systems for asylum, integration or return will not be able to cope in the event of large flows. Based on a holistic assessment, the Commission is proposing a fresh start on migration: building confidence through more effective procedures and striking a new balance between responsibility and solidarity.

A capacidade de financiamento da economia situou-se em 1,0% do Produto Interno Bruto (PIB) no ano acabado no 2º trimestre de 2020, aumentando 0,1 pontos percentuais (p.p.) face ao trimestre anterior. O Rendimento Disponível Bruto (RDB) e o PIB nominal diminuíram 2,8% e 3,3% no ano acabado no 2º trimestre de 2020.

O Instituto Nacional de Estatística disponibilizou a terceira edição da publicação nacional de acompanhamento estatístico da Agenda 2030 da ONU, intitulada “Objetivos de Desenvolvimento Sustentável: Indicadores para Portugal | Agenda 2030”.

A partir da monitorização dos indicadores disponíveis é possível ter uma noção sobre o desempenho do país em relação aos ODS, verificando-se progressos em alguns deles, nomeadamente nos domínios da redução da pobreza, do acesso à saúde e das energias renováveis.

[Refira-se] que a informação deste destaque não reflete ainda a situação atual determinada pela pandemia Covid19. É de esperar que as tendências aqui analisadas se alterem substancialmente. De qualquer modo, a informação disponibilizada será útil para estabelecer uma referência para avaliar desenvolvimentos futuros.

O VAB do setor dos bens e serviços ambientais diminuiu 0,9% em 2017, mas as exportações e o emprego cresceram mais do que no total da economia – 2017

O Produto Interno Bruto per capita, expresso em Paridades de Poder de Compra, situou-se em 76,8% da média da União Europeia em 2018 (76,6% em 2017). A Despesa de Consumo individual per capita aumentou de 81,5% da média da União Europeia em 2017 para 82,9% em 2018
